Residential Permit Parking (RPP)

VISITOR PASSES:

By Ordinance, residents are entitled to 14 calendar days in one year of visitor passes. ***No visitor passes will be issued to north side residents during MUSIKFEST.*** To obtain a visitor pass, you must provide:

1. Resident's name and address.
2. License plate.
3. Make and color of vehicle.
4. Dates of visit.

CALL IN'S:

Call in's will be accepted only when **unexpected** company arrives or unusual circumstances occur (**emergency service repairs**). Monday thru Friday 8a.m. - 4p.m.

WHAT TO DO WHEN PURCHASING A NEW VEHICLE OR PLATE:

Permits are non-transferrable and valid only on the **vehicle & plate registered** at the time of application. When selling, trading or getting a new plate on your vehicle, you **MUST** return the old permit in order to receive a new permit **FREE** of cost, and bring in your new registration & insurance card. In the case of an accident, if possible, try to remove the permit.

LOANER VEHICLES:

Should your vehicle go into the mechanic for repairs and you are using a loaner vehicle, contact our office immediately. If using the loaner vehicle for more than one day, you must obtain a visitor pass.

PLEASE NOTE:

The illegal transfer or selling of RPP permits is subject to a fine of no less than \$100.00 nor greater than \$300.00 and/or up to 90 days in prison.
